Class: Exploring Landscape with the Group of Seven

OVERVIEW

Class 1: PowerPoint Introduction to the Course, Group of 7 History, and Analysis of their compositions.
4-Stages painting method explained. You will do pen/pencil exercises in your sketchbooks.
Class 2: Start painting your chosen image. Newcomers will copy a Group of 7 image first using the 4-Stages method. Repeat students may choose their own original image using styles and colours based on Group of 7 techniques.

In **Class 6***: "One Painting in Two Hours" – an optional fun exercise copying a Group of 7 "plein air" image but done in the studio.

Material List:

Sketchbook Exercises (All Classes)

- Pencil, Eraser, Ruler
- Black ballpoint pen or fine black pigment liner

Painting Supplies (Class 2 onwards)

- Types of Paints plus Mediums
 - Acrylics paints,
 - plus Acrylic Fluid Matte Medium, and thicker Gel Medium (optional)
 - Oil paints, plus odour-free Solvents and Mediums
 - Watercolours
- Colours

For Class 2 : Required Hues Underpainting: Raw Sienna, Burnt Sienna, Ultramarine Blue, Titanium White

For Class 3 onwards: <u>Suggested Hues</u> include Yellow, Yellow Ochre or Yellow Oxide, Cadmium Red, Crimson, Dioxazine Violet, Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue, Viridian or Phthalo Green

- Palette Knife
- Disposable Palette (for acrylics and oils) of White or Grey sheets
- Selection of Brushes
- Clean-up supplies

Painting Supports (Size depends on scale and ratio of your individual projects)

For Oils/Acrylics: Good quality, stretched and primed canvases 16 by 20 inches or larger recommended. *For **Class 6** Exercise - 1 stretched Canvas or Canvas Board (10''x12'' or 11''x14'' or 12''x16'' - depends on chosen image)

For Watercolours: Good quality Watercolour paper, size and type of your choice

Important Note: Art Stores are having supply issues during this pandemic. Bring what you have and don't worry if you are missing items. We will find solutions together.

Beginners - The **Liquitex Basics Acrylic Set of 6** (118ml tubes) – Napthol Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, Yellow, Phthalo Green plus Black and White works quite well but also buy <u>the Required Hues</u> listed above.

Fluid Medium is for thin acrylic washes. Gel Medium (optional) is for impasto or thicker brushwork. *Optional: Grey Matters Paper Palette*, 50 sheets, 9 by 12 or larger is useful for mixing correct tonal values. It is grey-toned, with a Greyscale and a *Quiller Colour Wheel*.
