Materials List:

Acrylic or oil Paints

These are my suggestions but variations on these colours will work as well depending on brand of paint:

- Prussian Blue
- Phthalo Blue (green shade)
- Phthalo Blue light
- Cadmium or Quinacridone Red
- Cadmium Medium Yellow
- Cadmium Light Yellow
- Yellow Ochre
- Burnt Umber
- Raw Umber
- light magenta
- medium magenta
- a large tube of Titanium white

You do not necessarily need to bring:
Orange or Green paints as we will be learning to mix our own.
Also any other colours you want to add.

Brushes:

- some flats and filberts 1/8 to 1" suitable for acrylics or oils
- some rounds brushes, small medium and large sizes.

- "CANVAS PAPER" pad 9" x 12" or larger or even some small dollar store canvases for small studies.
- 2 medium size canvases range from 16 to 24 inch square or rectangle format. IE: 16 x 20, 24 x 24 etc.

- Palette for mixing colours
- Rags or paper towel
- Pencil
