Papers: White - Large Sketchbook (min. 11" x 14") or large pad of Bond paper

Black and Mid-value Greys – minimum 3 of each black and greys

Canson Mi Teintes is a good choice and comes in small pads as well as single sheets, large and small. Large sheets are a good option, and can be cut down for multiple drawings.

- Pencils, assorted
- Charcoal and or conte sticks
- Erasers, white and kneaded
- Drawing Pen – ie: Sakura Pigma Micron 01 (or comparable)
- Coloured Pencils
- White and Black pencils – these can be from the coloured pencil kit, or you may opt to use charcoal, conte sticks, white pastel or conte pencils, etc.
