Class: Introduction to Pen and Ink

Material List:

1. A pen

- dip pen for ink: nib holder and fine nib or fountain pen OR
- fine point felt tip pen or marker o OR
- technical drawing pen OR
- any combination of these

2. Ink

- If using a dip pen: black Ink (optional a sepia ink)
- If using a fountain pen, make sure the ink is suitable for fountain pens.

Some possible brands for dip pens are:

- -FW by Daler Rowney
- -Winsor Newton Drawing Ink
- -Ecoline by Talens
- -Aerocolor by Schmincke

3. Paper

- A Small sketchbook for studies, preferably for mixed media which has heavier weight paper.
- Drawing pad with smooth paper, preferably heavyweight, for finished drawings. e.g., bristol paper

4. Etc.

- Pencil: HB or 2B
- pencil sharpener
- eraser- kneaded or vinyl
- ruler
- soft brush to remove eraser debris
