Class: Layering Resist and Watercolour Workshop

Materials List:

- Watercolour tube paints in your choice of red, yellow, and blue, plus a few others of your choosing. No need for black or white.
- A small bottle of latex free masking fluid, but NOT a masking fluid pen. Some brands at Curry's include Demco, Winsor & Newton, and Pebeo.
- A couple of cheap round brushes that can be used to apply masking fluid in small sizes, like 2 or 3. You won't be able to paint with these brushes once you use them for masking fluid, so inexpensive brushes you might not choose to paint with are just fine.
- Cold-press watercolour paper, 140 lb, or heavier, around 9 by 12, or similar size. You will also need sturdy cardboard or another strong board for mounting your paper. Please bring more than one, so you can put one piece aside to dry while we begin another one.
- Brushes round size 10 or 12, flat or bright 1", and anything else of your choosing, but we will typically be using larger brushes that hold a lot of water and pigment for loose work.
- Spray bottle
- Masking tape 1.5" thick
- Feel free to bring other materials that you feel could enhance your work including oil pastels, or markers. That part will be up to you!
