**Material List:**

*Please note that due to Covid we will not be sharing as we have in the past, so as much of your own materials is best - thus the materials list appears to be more extensive than usual. Most important are tools to work with, substrate to work on and papers to apply.*

**Basic supplies:**

- Paint brushes
- pencil
- ruler
- exacto knife or similar
- Cutting mat
- scissors
- glue stick (prefer non acid, UHU brand is a good choice)
- matte or gloss medium for gluing ( not gel medium it is thicker)
- water container
- paint palette (wax paper works for this as well)
- paper towels,
- stapler (if you have one)
- Sketch books for notes and drawings

**Acrylic paints:**

- Red
- Blue
- Yellow
- Black
- White
- Other colours at your discretion

**Substrate surface to work on:**

We do several studies each day, so pads of **watercolour paper (140 lb)** or **Bristol paper pads 9"x12"** are a workable size. (My choice is XL brand with the blue cover; Deserres has the best price) If you want to work on **boards** or **canvas** (or something you already have in supply) that is your choice, just make sure you have an ample supply.

We will be painting some of our own papers so if you have things to make marks for scratching or stencils, such as forks, sticks, plastic stencils, plastic wrap, etcetera

**Materials to collage may include**

- Old books
- Magazines
- Tissue paper
- Children's books

- Newspaper
- Saved notes
- Receipts
- Paper bags
- Found things
- String or thread
- Scrap book paper
- Old cards or letters
- Photocopies
- Fabric scraps

For the most part find materials you have around rather than go out to purchase. Check blue boxes!  
Anything you can think of that might be of interest to you.  
Lessons include looking for colours in papers and images
