#### **Materials List:**

Acrylic ink bottles with dropper, I.e Liquitex or Daler Rowney brands. You definitely need black and white, but choose a few colours you love that you'll be excited to use. My preferred ink lately has been the Daler Rowney brand.

Watercolor paper, hot or cold press, not lighter than 90 lb; 140 lb paper is ideal. Size can be 8x10 or larger.

Watercolor brushes. A round size 10 or 12, a flat 1/2 inch or 1 inch, and perhaps a small round size 4 or 6. We do have plenty that size in the classroom that you can borrow that day. You'll be glad you purchased the first two.

Small bottle of alcohol, 90% ideal but 70% will work.

A few bamboo skewers.

A piece of cardboard or firm board slightly larger than your work.

Optional: gel pens and colors that will stand out from your ink. Sometimes I like to use a metallic or a white pen for finer detail and doodles.
