Class: Painting for the Petrified (Online)

Material List:

Acrylic paints: You only need to get student grade paints – these are more economical when you are first learning! A 120 ml size tube of the below colours is needed.

- Red
- Yellow (cadmium)
- Blue (cobalt)
- White

Watercolour Paint:

You will need to get a minimum 12 colour set– this looks like the ones you used as a kid in art class with the paints set in a plastic tray. They are a great starting point for learning this medium. If you truly enjoy it you can graduate to sets of tubes, but for now – we are going to stay very basic.

Brushes:

We are not going to concentrate on advanced brushes for this class – you will be using the following for both watercolour and acrylic painting. Please make sure that the brushes you buy have synthetic bristles (i.e., nylon filament, Taklon or polyester). Alternatively, if you find a set for a great price that has these four brushes or more, you can get that instead of individual brushes.

Flat Brushes: for spreading paint quickly and evenly over a surface.

- 1 small flat brush
- 1 medium flat brush



Round Brushes: pointed tip, long closely arranged bristles for detail.

- 1 small round brush
- 1 small pointed round brush



Painting surfaces:

- **Paper:** You will be using a mixed media pad for this class – please get a minimum size of 9"x12" in sketchbook format.
- **Canvas Board:** one 9"x12" – these have been available at Dollarama as well as more traditional art supply shops

Other supplies:

- A reusable water container (empty yogurt containers are perfect for this!)
- Paper towels or rags
- A drawing pencil
- eraser
